### Quad Kids Results

We've had the results in for the Years 2, Year 3 and year 4 Quad Kids events and I'm delighted to be able to say that we have won all three. Fingers crossed for the Year 5 and 6 results.

### SATS results

We've had another excellent set of SATS results with our 100% of our Year 6 pupils reaching the expected standard in both the Reading and Grammar/Spelling/Punctuation tests. 97% of them achieved expected in Maths. The combined % of all pupils achieving expected for Reading, Writing and Maths is also 97%. Our percentages of pupils achieving the greater depth level in the tests were Grammar 85%, Reading 73% and Maths 73%. These are higher than the national averages for pupil achieving the expected levels. The pupils worked really hard to get these results so well done to them and to all the staff who have contributed to their education in their whole time at Yardley.
